
PROGRAM TO PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Purpose:

UWSP University graduation requirements for a Bachelor of Science Degree will need to be completed: 32 credits at 300 and 400 level and 120 total minimum credits.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- 1. Associate degree graduates must have earned a minimum grade point average of 2.50. An ineligible candidate may appeal for consideration through the Head, School of Business and Economics.
- 2. UWSP's Practicum in Computing Excel course (CIS 102) will be waived for incoming transfer students per this articulation agreement.
- 3. The acceptance of credits applies only to this Program-to-Program Articulation.
- 4. For acceptance of equivalent courses, Madison College courses must have been completed within the last 5 years. Beyond this period, course equivalents will be assessed on an individual basis.
- 5. The Agreement shall become effective on the 1st day of Jan 2025 and shall automatically renew on each July 1, for an additional year, unless terminated through written notice by either Party to this Agreement.
- 6. On an annual basis the UWSP School of Business and Economics will receive contact information for students enrolled in the Madison College Accounting program in order for the School of Business and Economics to provide advice on transferring into UWSP and the Accounting program.
