SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- 1. All UWSP students need to complete 40 credits at the 300/400 level and 120 total credits minimum.
- 2. The acceptance of credits applies only to this specific Program-to-Program Articulation.
- 3. Students are only eligible to participate in this agreement if transferring from NTC and majoring in Sociology at UWSP
- 4. For acceptance of equivalent courses, NTC courses must have been completed within the last 5 years. Beyond this period of time, course equivalents will be assessed on an individual basis.
- 5. Students transferring under this agreement must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25 in associate program coursework at NTC.
- 6. This agreement is subject to review if either NTC or UWSP undergoes curriculum revision OR within five years of the origination date of this agreement, whichever occurs earlier.
